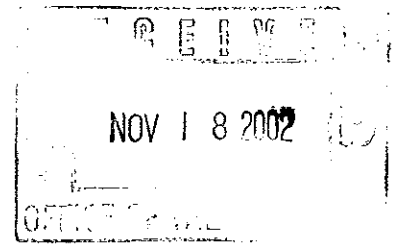

The NASAD Commission on Accreditation at its October meetings gave careful consideration to the response in support of the application for renewal of Membership submitted by Indiana State University.

The Commission voted to accept the response and continue the institution in good standing with the following degree listing:

- Bachelor of Arts – 4 years: Art History.
- Bachelor of Fine Arts – 4 years: Studio Art (Ceramics, Drawing, Graphic Design, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, Sculpture/Wood/Studio Furniture, Interdisciplinary Study).
- Bachelor of Science – 4 years: Studio Art (Ceramics, Drawing, Graphic Design, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, Sculpture/Wood/Studio Furniture, Interdisciplinary Study); Art Education.
- Master of Arts – 1 to 2 years: Bachelor of Fine Arts – 4 years: Studio Art (Ceramics, Drawing, Graphic Design, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, Sculpture/Wood/Studio Furniture).
- Master of Fine Arts – 2 or 3 years: Bachelor of Fine Arts – 4 years: Studio Art (Ceramics, Drawing, Graphic Design, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, Sculpture/Wood/Studio Furniture).

Plan Approved:

*Bachelor of Science – 4 years: Interior Design.*

The next NASAD review for renewal of Membership is scheduled for the 2010-2011 academic year.

The Commission voted to grant Plan Approval for the following degree program:

*Bachelor of Science – 4 years: Interior Design.*

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When three transcripts are available for this program, the institution should submit an application for Final Approval for Listing. Appropriate procedures should be requested from the NASAD National Office.

This action is taken upon review of Indiana State University according to accreditation standards in effect in October of 2002. As a member of NASAD, the institution is responsible for participating in all revisions and additions to the standards as well as maintaining its curricular programs in the visual arts current with NASAD standards as these are developed.
