Dear Dr. Roberts-Pittman:

At its meeting on July 17-21, 2013, the Commission on Accreditation (CoA) of the American Psychological Association reviewed your letter dated June 21, 2013 requesting that the Counseling Psychology program at Indiana State University remain on "Accredited, inactive" status for the 2013-2014 academic year. You also provided an update on the status of the remaining students in the program.

The CoA voted to continue the Ph.D. program on "Accredited, inactive" status for academic year 2013-2014. The program will continue to be listed as "Accredited, inactive" in the December 2013 *American Psychologist* and on the Accreditation webpages. Programs that are "accredited, inactive" are expected to pay the annual fee as part of that status.

According to the Accreditation Operating Procedures, inactive status can only be granted for one year at a time. In your letter, you indicated that the remaining nine students are expected to graduate by May 2014. By July 1, 2014, please provide the CoA with either a request for continued inactive status for academic year 2014-2015 (and update on progress of remaining students), or notification of the program's closure and withdrawal from accreditation.
