FACULTY SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE **REPORT FOR APRIL 22, 2003**

The Faculty Senate Executive Committee met at 3:15 p.m. on Tuesday, April 22, 2003 in Hulman Memorial Student Union, room 227.

Associate Vice President Richard Antonak reported that the Provost was not able to be present.

CHAIR BELL REPORTED

1) The Spring Faculty Meeting will take place Tuesday, April 29 at 3:15 in Dede II

FIFTEEN MINUTE OPEN DISCUSSION

1) Enforcement of prerequisites: Some problems have occurred when course numbers have been changed to a more advanced level. Registration systems should immediately automatically block enrollments of students who do not have the requisite number of hours/class standing.

ACTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

- 1) FAC recommendation on the School of Technology Constitution: Accepted to forward to the Senate. Discussion of the status of deans as voting members of the faculty, as stated in the Faculty Constitution of the University Handbook.
- 2) AAC/FAC recommendation on the Affirmative Action Sexual Harassment Policy: Accepted as amended to forward to the Senate. Discussion of the mandatory reporting policy, university officials bound by the policy, what options they have, legal status of written records of informal investigations, role of the Affirmative Action Officer in the practice of law.
- 3) SAC recommendation on the Add/Drop Policy: Accepted as amended.

The meeting adjourned at 5:30.
