MATH AREA FOR SCIENCE EDUCATION LICENSURE

The Indiana Standards Board has ruled that effective June 30, 2006, Rules 2006 licensure for Science Education will not include math as a content area. All math licensure will be granted only through degree programs in mathematics. Effective June 30, 2006, students should be advised that they should not pursue the current Science Education curriculum with a major or minor area in Mathematics if they are seeking Science Education licensure in Indiana under Rules 2002. DARS should carry the following message for students in Science Education:

Effective June 30, 2006, mathematics is not recognized by the Indiana Professional Standard Board for licensure in Science Education under Rules 2002. Students pursuing a Rules 2002 license in Science Education should see their advisor if they have questions about their degree plan.

PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

Program articulations agreements between Indiana State University and our two-year partner institutions allow students to complete a specific associate degree program at another institution and receive credit toward a specific bachelor's degree program at Indiana State University. Each agreement details the transfer courses accepted for credit at ISU, the courses needed to complete the bachelor's degree, and any other requirements or guidelines that apply.
