DEPARTMENTS NAME CHANGE

COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES: Criminology

The Department of Criminology in the College of Arts and Sciences has requested that the Department name be changed from Criminology to Criminology and Criminal Justice.

Rationale: The designation “Criminology” alone is not an adequate or accurate description of who we are or what we do as a department and as individual scholars. The department has experienced difficulty in recruiting new faculty and (especially graduate) students because “Criminal Justice” does not appear in the department’s name. Almost all of ISU’s peer institutions include “Criminal Justice” in their department or program name as well. The faculty vote on this proposal was 9-1-0.

The Board of Trustees approved the department name change, **effective October 1, 2007**, at its June 22, 2007 meeting.

COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY: Aerospace Technology

Faculty have voted to change the name of the Department of Aerospace Technology to Department of Aviation Technology.

The change accurately reflects the nature of what the department does which is Aviation Training. There is no “space” component to the degree programs and the current title, while well intentioned, is misleading. This change accurately reflects the dominant name of the majority of similar degree programs around this nation. This name change not only describes the department’s mission more appropriately, but is a factor in recruitment as well. The faculty vote on this proposal was 7-0-0.

The Board of Trustees approved the department name change, **effective October 1, 2007**, at its June 22, 2007 meeting.
