## **ENVI426 – Latin American Environments**

This one is hard to cite, but for a discussion forum students had to listen to a youtube excerpt of "Latinoamerica" by the musical group Calle 13 and discuss why the chorus talks about buying things, particularly natural processes. Another case that is difficult is how to reconcile the "neocolonial paranoia" of some Latin American nations, but particularly Brazil, and its cultural friendship with U.S. artists. Students have to compare the messages in Latin American street art (graffiti) that targets the global hegemony and "imperialist" actions of the United States (provided to them in photographs taken by me) with those of global friendship in popular music by Brazilian artists (e.g., Marcelo D2's "Sangue Bom"). This activity closes with a consideration of how this tension informs Brazil's relationship with the rest of the world in terms of pressures to combat deforestation in the Amazon.
