Year 3	PHIL 333 <i>and/or</i> Elective	PHIL 330 or 335 <i>Elective may also be taken</i>
Year 4	PHIL 303 or 401* Elective	Elective(s)

* **N.B.:** Either PHIL 303 or 401 must be taken in the fall of senior year as the required culminating experiential learning course in the Philosophy major. Students may take either 303 or 401 in the fall of their junior year as an elective, but it will not count as their culminating experiential learning requirement.
