At its August 6-9, 2015 meeting, ACOTE reviewed the Plan of Correction submitted by the Occupational Therapy Master's Program at Indiana State University, Terre Haute, Indiana. The following areas of noncompliance that were cited by ACOTE in April 2015 are considered fully corrected. No further report is required at this time.

- A.4.11. Appropriate Use of Equipment and Supplies
- C.1.1. FW Program Reflects the Curriculum Design

Additional Comment:

Because the cited areas of noncompliance have been fully resolved within 1 year of ACOTE's accreditation action, ACOTE further voted to grant a 2-year extension of the accreditation term previously awarded. Therefore, the next on-site evaluation of the occupational therapy master's program has been moved to the 2021/2022 academic year and the program's Interim Report due date adjusted to spring 2018. A revised ACOTE Certificate of Accreditation that reflects the extension of the accreditation term will be forwarded to the program director.
