
Dear Megan,

The Accreditation Council for Genetic Counseling is pleased to grant Accredited New Program accreditation status to the graduate program in genetic counseling at Indiana State University effective April 4, 2016.

To maintain accreditation, an annual accreditation fee and Report of Current Status form must be submitted each year by June 15th. Accreditation fee invoices will be distributed in January. The current fee for Accredited New Program status is \$4,500. Your accreditation will be reviewed and renewed annually following submission of your program's complete Report of Current Status, providing there are no points that, in the Board's judgement, seriously compromise the education of your students. Accreditation will remain in effect until a determination is made following your program's application for Full Accreditation, which is due no more than one year after graduation of your second class.
